



INTAS Collaborative Call with Moldova 2005

In 2005 INTAS launches a Collaborative Call for research project proposals with Moldova, with a budget of **€ 1.0 million**, shared between Moldova (approximately € 250,000) and INTAS (approximately € 750,000).

Scope:

The scope will cover seven fields of research:

- Citizens and governance in a knowledge-based society;
- Biomedicine for human health;
- Molecular biology and creation of plant varieties and hybrids;
- Information technologies;
- Nanotechnologies, new materials;
- Energetic security;
- Efficient use of natural resources.

The call encompasses basic and applied research but excludes market-oriented technology development.

Consortium:

The project consortia must comprise at least two teams from two different INTAS member states, including the coordinator; and at least one team from Moldova. The consortia are open to teams from NIS other than Moldova.

Duration of projects:

The project duration must be 18, 24 or 30 months.

Maximum allowable funding:

The maximum allowable funding per project is **100,000€** subject to the scientific content, the duration and the number of scientists involved. No more than **25%** of the total project grant will be available to teams from INTAS member states.

Submission and deadlines:

Proposals must be submitted through the INTAS internet-based submission system.

The call will be opened on 3 May 2005, 9.00am Brussels time and closed 6 September 2005, 9.00am Brussels time.
